BIKE SHARING PROGRAM PARTNERSHIP WITH CITY OF BURLINGAME AND SPIN APPROVED BY COUNCIL

City Council gave approval for staff to move forward to negotiate and execute a contract with the bike-sharing vendor Spin, for a multijurisdictional electric bike-sharing program with the City of Burlingame. We are excited to partner with The City of Burlingame to create alternative options for transportation between our Cities.

Millbrae is home to the Peninsula's premier intermodal transit station and serves as a gateway to the Bay Area, California, and international destinations. The addition of the bike-sharing program will enhance the accessibility of visitors. This program makes both Millbrae and Burlingame more accessible and reduces vehicle traffic, congestion, and greenhouse gas emissions.

The approval of this program enhances the vision of the Millbrae General Plan, and Downtown Specific Plan that are set to be adopted by the Council at the November 15th Council Meeting. These plans lay the groundwork for the City of Millbrae's reimagined El Camino Real as a bicyclist and pedestrian safe haven, with wider sidewalks, and dedicated bike lanes. We are pleased with this project and how it will seamlessly fit with Millbrae's vision.

The midterm elections are fast approaching - do you know how you'll make your voice heard? Whether you're planning to vote in person, by mail, or just have questions about how to participate, we have resources to support you.

Your Sample Ballot & Official Voter Information Pamphlet should be arriving shortly. The pamphlet provides a wealth of information to voters on candidates, measures, and voter services for the November 8, 2022, Statewide General Election. Voters in the Millbrae City Council Districts 2 and 4 will vote to elect a City Councilmember from each respective district for a four-year term. The Hillcrest Subbasin 4 Sewer Project will be performing pavement/trench restoration on the following streets in the next couple weeks:

- 300-400 block of Palm Ave
- 300 block of Hazel Ave
- 300 block of Laurel Ave
- 200-300 block of Ashton Ave
- 300 block of El Paseo
- 800 block of Almenar St
- 800 block of Hillcrest Blvd

The City of Millbrae will begin work on our Pavement Maintenance Project funded through general funds throughout the City beginning October 24, 2022. The project is estimated to take thirty days and will take place Monday through Friday during normal business hours.

This project is planned to conduct work on the following streets:

- Palm Avenue
- Queen Anne Court
- Santa Florita Avenue
- Santa Susana Avenue
- El Bonito Way
- Millbrae Circle




