Here are some tips to protect you and your families during this upcoming holiday season.

- Install a sturdy deadbolt lock on every door leading to the outside.
- Install motion-sensing floodlights in the front and back of your home that are on timers.
- If you will be out of town, work with your neighbors and friends to create a "lived-in look" while you are away. Some examples might include, having someone mow your lawn, pick up your mail, have your mail stopped, do not leave unattended mail in your mailbox and have a car in the driveway.

## SHOPPING SAFETY TIPS:



- Shop during daylight hours whenever possible. If you have to shop at night, ask a friend or family to go with you.
- Dress casually and comfortably.
- Don't wear any expensive jewelry.
- Try to avoid carrying large amounts of cash and pay with your cards.

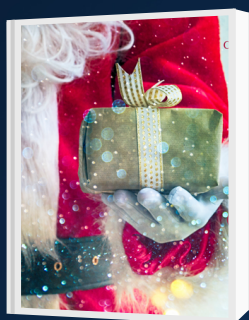

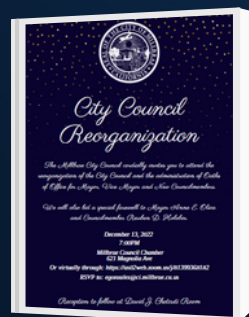
