iOS and Android Phone Apps are now available for download!

The City of Millbrae recently launched the new request management software Millbrae Works powered by SeeClickFix. The application called Millbrae Works is available for all residents to download on any iOS or Android device.

The Millbrae Works app allows the City of Millbrae residents who identify community repair or service request needs to submit photos, location information, and request details directly to The City of Millbrae administrative staff members. In addition, the platform provides The City of Millbrae officials with a centralized system to manage issues from creation to resolution — engaging residents throughout the process.

The software also enables duplicate detection so that if a resident begins to submit a request already in the system, it will promptly notify them and enable them to follow the existing request. This reduces duplicate requests and increases the City of Millbrae's services.

Thus far, we have had a total of twenty-two requests. We appreciate all who have already used this new software management software and look forward to the continued success of the implementation.
