GATEWAY AT MILLBRAE STATION GRAND OPENING!

The City of Millbrae with Republic Urban Properties celebrated the Grand Opening of Gateway at Millbrae Station community on Thursday, April 20, 2023. This project is located at the transit hub that serves BART, Caltrain, and the San Francisco Airport. The Gateway at Millbrae Station offers terrific amenities with many opportunities for new residents, travelers, and businesses. It is comprised of 157,000 Square feet of Class A office space, a 164-room hotel, 320 market-rate apartments, 80-veteran-preferred affordable housing units, and 44,000 square feet of mixed-use retail. The 80 veteran-preferred affordable housing units are now fully occupied, with a third of the occupancy as veterans. "The Gateway at Millbrae Station is an excellent project with multiple land uses and one that truly defines what a Transit Oriented Development project should be," says City Manager Tom Williams. This is a model TOD project! Bringing together jobs and housing all in one place, a new neighborhood



blending neighbors and retail and biotech all in one place.

Gateway also demonstrates how a public-private partnership between a developer, city, and transit agency can successfully transform underutilized land into an exciting new space bursting with economic potential. "Gateway is an urban planning success story," asserts Michael Van Every, President, and Managing Partner of Republic Urban Properties. "This project combines every attractive asset class in commercial categories—hotel, office, retail, and residential. The vision is ambitious; the key to success in a public-private partnership like this one, however, is how you

SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL

“School Travel Fellowship”

The City of Millbrae was selected for the San Mateo County Office of Education Safe Routes to School "School Travel Fellowship" program to address issues related to student travel at Green Hills Elementary and Meadows Elementary Schools. The Millbrae team is an interdisciplinary team and includes collaboration with engineering, planning, environmental programs and the principals and other leaders at the schools. As part of the fellowship, the Millbrae team is receiving technical assistance from Alta Planning + Design, an active transportation company dedicated to creating active, healthy communities through planning, landscape architecture, engineering, and education/encouragement programs.

The project goal is to improve crossings in school zones at Green Hills Elementary and Meadows Elementary, particularly near drop-off and pick-up areas, promote walking and biking to school,

and help the schools address safety and traffic concerns. These improvements will help increase the number of students who regularly walk or bike to and from school instead of transport by car, which among many benefits will reduce greenhouse gases.

The team conducted a Safe Routes to School walk audit at Meadows Elementary School this morning Friday April 21, 2023. A walk audit is a community-driven process to identify changes in your neighborhood to make walking and biking safer, more accessible, and comfortable for school children and the surrounding community.

Once the walk audit data is collected a demonstration project at both schools will be planned. The City is excited to have been selected for the Safe Routes to School “School Travel Fellowship” program and looks forward to making our students commute to schools safer within our community.

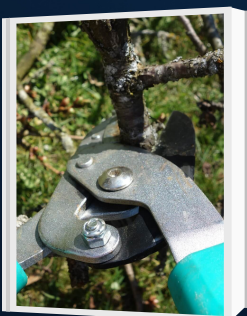
