Housing Element Update

On April 25, 2023, the City of Millbrae City Council reviewed and adopted the 6th Cycle Housing Element Update. The Housing Element Update is a blueprint for accommodating the City's Regional Housing Needs Allocation of 2,199 units over the next eight years.

The state of California requires each jurisdiction to accommodate a certain number of housing units through zoning. The Housing Element was revised in response to the State of California Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) comments.

The revised document contains additional data and clarifications

requested by HCD and emphasizes the City's programs related to equal access and housing mobility and the inclusion of updated building permit issuance information per the 2022 Annual Progress Report. The City will submit the Housing Element to HCD. HCD has 60 days to review the revisions and certify the Housing Element or provide additional comments.

Millbrae Celebrate Bike Month!

Whether you bike every day or once every couple of months - to work, school, farmer's market, or library - you're invited to join thousands in celebration of the humble bicycle. May is Bike Month, and you, your friends, and your family are welcome to ride with us on May 18, 19, and 20 for Bike to Wherever Days. Will you pledge to ride?

Millbrae will host an Energizer station at Caltrain's southbound platform at Millbrae intermodal station on May 18th, from 7:00 -10:00 AM. Energizer stations provide support and encouragement to Wherever Day event participants. Energizer Station volunteers staff them and offer musette bags (a small bicycling bag with one shoulder strap), other fun giveaways, and bicycling advocacy information.

We'll be asking people to "Pledge to ride." When you pledge to ride, you can get a free Bike to Wherever Days 2023 tote bag on the days of the event (if you get to a station before they run out), and you will be entered into a random drawing for prizes as well.

Coming May 11, 2023, Spin, in partnership with the Cities of Millbrae and Burlingame, will launch a joint bike-share program.

The soft launch will include 40 bikes placed in corrals in Millbrae and 40 bikes in corrals in Burlingame.

Riders will be able to rent e-bikes for use within the cities of Millbrae and Burlingame. Riders must be 18 years or older. Riders are encouraged to park in one of the many corrals located within each city and will receive discounts on future rides simply for parking in the marked corrals. Transition to Sewer Service Charges to County Tax Roll

The City of Millbrae provides wastewater treatment services to the Millbrae community. In the past, customers have received bi-monthly bills (six bills total) for these services. Beginning in the fiscal year 2023-24, the City plans to switch to semi-annual billing (two bills total) and collect the charges on the property tax bill. This change does not cause an increase in your current sewer rates.
