Alexandria Life Sciences Campus Topping Out Ceremony

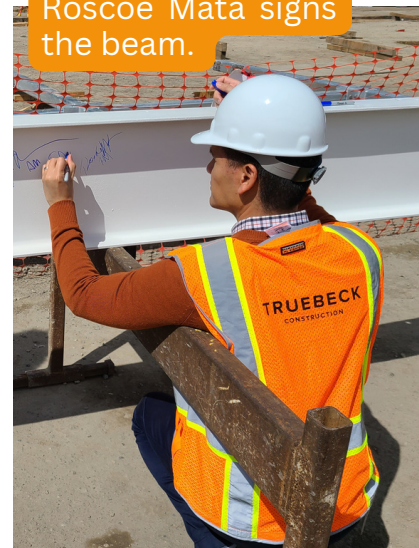
Truebeck Construction hosted a topping out celebration on Thursday, May 18, 2023, commemorating the placement of the final steel beam of the Alexandria Life Sciences Campus currently under construction at the corner of Millbrae Avenue and Rollins Road. The event was attended by staff from the City of Millbrae, developer Alexandria Real Estate Equities, Inc., project architects at WRNS Studio, and representatives of future

tenant Eikon Therapeutics. When completed, the 4.7-acre life sciences campus will consist of four buildings totaling approximately 570,000 square feet, containing laboratories and office space for an estimated 2,055 professionals working in the biotechnology industry. The entire project is expected to be completed by the Spring of 2025.
