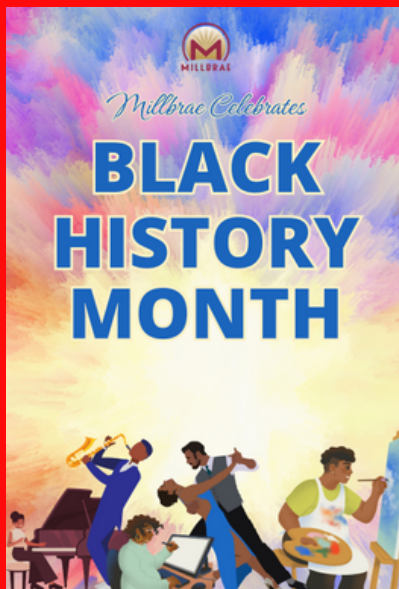

Is Winter Weather Wearing Out Your Retaining Wall?

Many residents in Millbrae live on hillsides where retaining walls provide structure and support to their property. Over the past few years, heavy seasonal rains have put tremendous strain on everyone's retaining walls. Water makes everything heavier, including the soil being supported behind your retaining wall. In some instances, it can also cause the soil to expand in size. Over time, this stress can weaken a retaining wall and cause it to buckle, lean or fail.

Your retaining wall should be inspected periodically for signs of stress and water damage. Evidence of wood rot, bulges, loose material, leaning, and cracks are critical signs that it may be time to repair or replace your retaining wall. A failed retaining wall can destabilize a slope and cause damage to both your own and your neighbors' properties. Emergency repairs and shoring during winter storms can be especially costly. The best time to repair and replace a retaining wall is when soil conditions are dry.



If you are thinking about repairing or replacing your retaining wall, remember a building permit is required if the wall is over 48" tall. In most cases, a construction plan prepared by a licensed civil engineer will be required for the project. Always check with the City's Building Division before starting work. If you have any questions or concerns about the condition of your retaining wall, we recommend having it inspected by a qualified professional contractor or engineer. If you have any questions about getting a building permit to repair or replace your retaining wall, don't hesitate to contact us at (650) 259-2330.

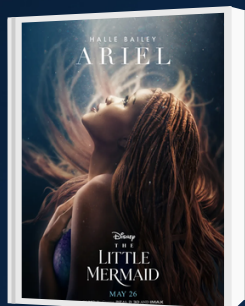
