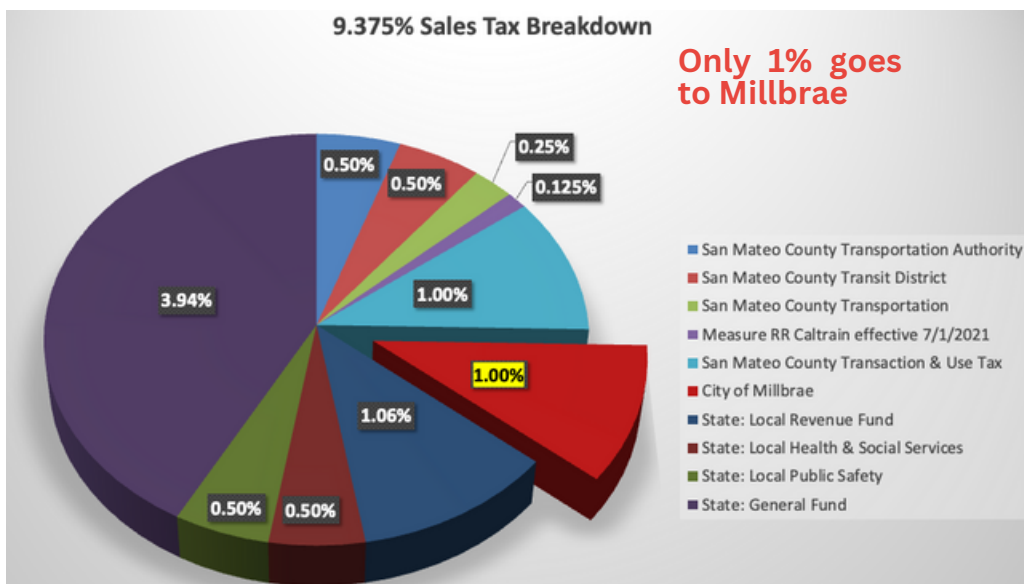

Do you know where your taxes go in the City of Millbrae?

We have broken down Sales Tax and Property Tax so that you know where your tax dollars are going.

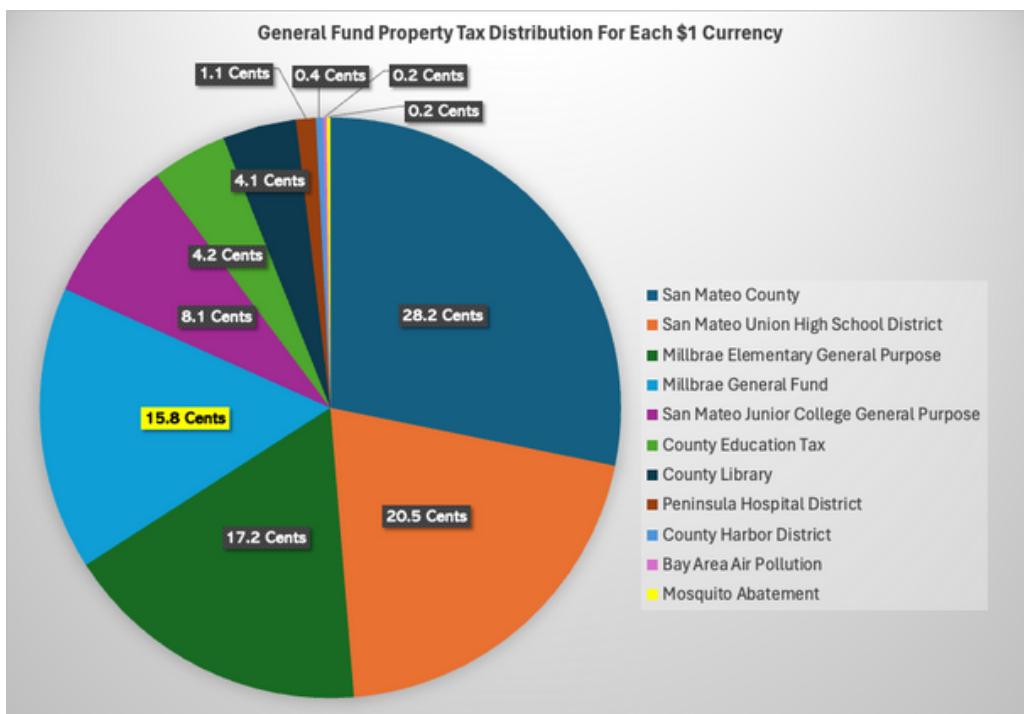
Chart 1



The sales tax in Millbrae is 9.375%. Only 1% of the sales tax goes directly to the City of Millbrae. The majority of the sales tax (6%) goes to the State of California. 2.25% goes to the County of San Mateo, and the remaining .13% goes to Measure RR Caltrain Effective. Please reference Chart 1 for a full breakdown of Sales Tax.

The General Fund Property Tax Distribution is divided between eleven different agencies. The Property Tax for each \$1 is broken down as follows, rounded to the nearest hundred cents: 28.2 cents to San Mateo County, 20.5 cents to San Mateo Union High School District, 17.2 cents to Millbrae Elementary General Purpose Fund, 15.8 cents to the City of Millbrae General Fund, 8.1 cents to San Mateo Junior College General Purpose Fund, 4.2 cents to County Education Tax, 4.1 cents to County Library, 1.1 cents to Peninsula Hospital District, .4 cents to County Harbor District, .2 cents to Bay Area Air Pollution, and .2 cents to Mosquito Abatement. Please reference Chart 2 for a breakdown of the General Fund Property Tax Distribution.

New Project to Establish Millbrae Development Standards for Residential Developments

Development Project Updates- The Old Office Depot

The 1.86-acre former Office Depot property was entitled in July 2022 to be redeveloped as a six-story mixed-use building consisting of 278 residential units, including 26 affordable units, and 17,210 square feet of retail, commercial space with two levels of interior parking. The project made substantial progress towards the commencement of construction in recent weeks. The developer acquired the property and recently resubmitted their demolition and building permits for review, including plans for the design of Meadow Glen Plaza, which are anticipated to be considered by the City Council sometime in April. The project recently completed and recorded the grant deed and lot line adjustment for Meadow Glen Plaza. Demolition of the former Office Depot building is expected to begin as early as this May.

City of Millbrae to Provide Financial Resources for Commute.Org

The City of Millbrae has entered into a professional agreement with the Peninsula Traffic Congestion Relief Alliance (Commute.org) for financial services to be provided by the City. Commute.org is a joint powers agency located in San Mateo County, comprised of 19 cities and towns and the county. Commute.org's mission is to reduce the number of vehicle miles traveled to decrease congestion, improve the environment, and enhance quality of life by encouraging and supporting the use of sustainable alternatives to driving alone.

The City of Millbrae will provide financial services including general accounting and bookkeeping, audit preparation, cashing, cash management, investments, billing inquiries, accounts payable, and preparation of annual audits. These services will be billed to Commute.org based on the City's fully burdened hourly rate and estimations of time required to provide these services. The estimated volume of transactions is low, and therefore, the work can be performed by the City's existing Finance staff. This will also provide an opportunity for finance staff to develop additional skills by acting as fiscal agents for other entities.
