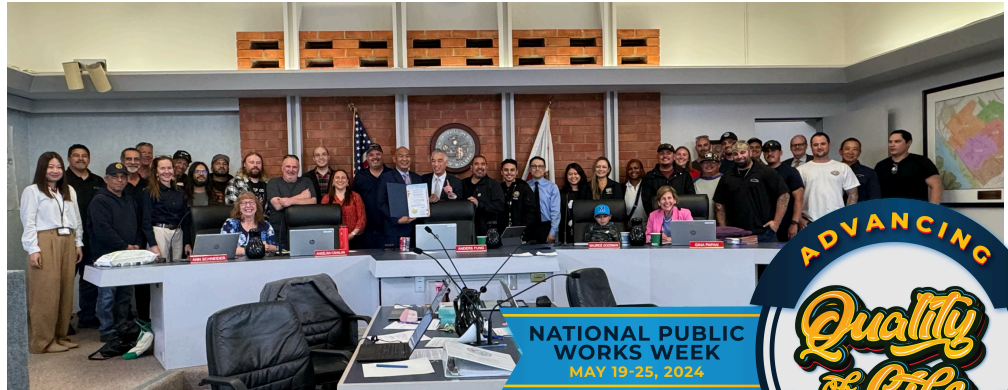

## NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK



May 19-25, 2024, is National Public Works Week, and this year marks the 64th Anniversary of the annual Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association and Canadian Public Works Association. This year's theme is "Advancing Quality of Life," which is a great tribute to the Millbrae Public Works Department, which works daily to advance the quality of Life for our community through infrastructure and amenities improvements.

The City of Millbrae Public Works Department has six divisions: Storms and Streets, Water, Parks, Sewer, Engineering, and Environmental Programs. The six divisions have a total of 65 employees. Millbrae Public Works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities, and services that are vital to a sustainable and resilient community, public health, high quality of life, and the well-being of the people of the City of Millbrae.

This week, we are recognizing the great work that our Public Works Professionals have accomplished in the last year such as the Upper Hillcrest Pavement Repair Project, Millbrae Library Makerspace, Central Park Tennis Court Resurfacing Project, Lincoln Circle Water Line, Streetlight and Pavement Rehabilitation Project, Santa Barbara Drive Pavement Rehabilitation Project, and the Skyline Water Tank Replacement Project. 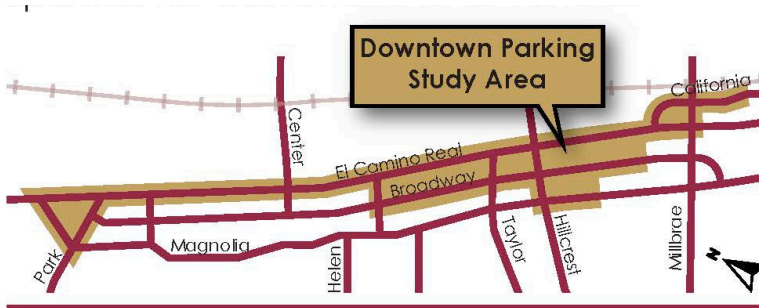

## Nearshore Outfall Restoration Project

The project is a construction project that will restore the outfall unit to working condition. An "outfall" is a point where treated water (effluent) is released into a body of water, such as the bay. Heavy rain events, increasing in frequency due to climate change, can lead to potential overflow of treated water at our treatment plant. In response, the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board mandated cities to establish a backup discharge, prompting the restoration of our deteriorated nearshore outfall structure to manage effluent during heavy rain events.

This construction will affect the bicycle lane along the South McDonnell Road at the intersection of Millbrae Avenue for approximately three months beginning May 6, 2024. Construction needs will shift the bike lane out toward the center of the road for approximately 350 feet, as shown on the traffic control plan image, for about 3 weeks. After the initial construction phase, bicyclists will share the road with vehicles at the construction entrance only, as shown on the second figure. This traffic control plan was crafted in cooperation with SFO International Airport in an effort to properly serve pedestrian, vehicle, and bicycle traffic as best as possible during this critical project.

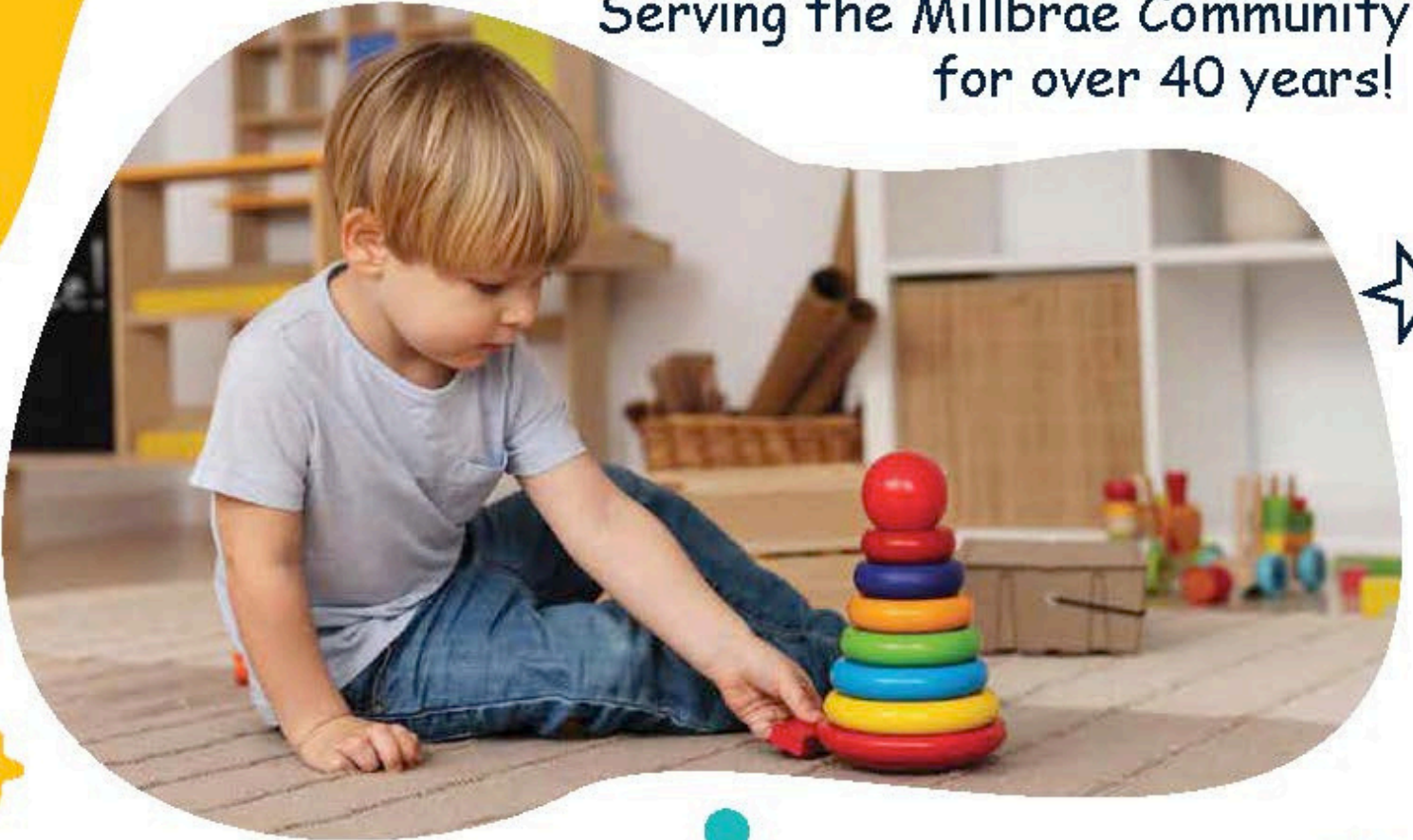

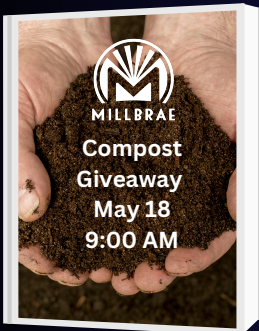
