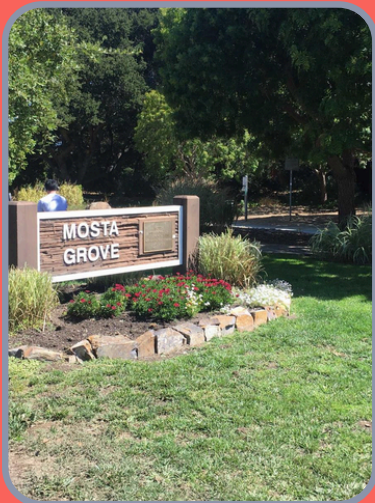

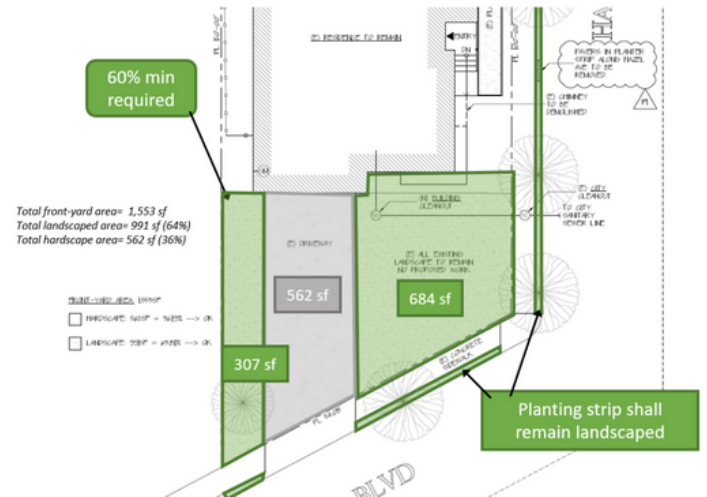
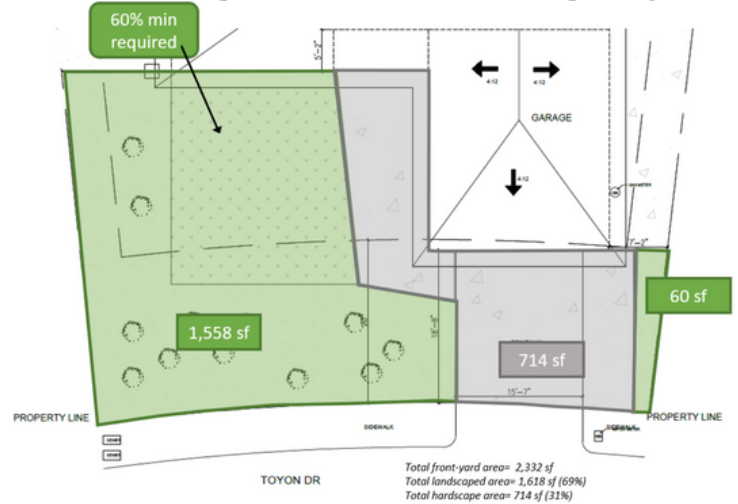

FRONT YARD LANDSCAPING

The City of Millbrae has a minimum front yard landscaping requirement. The Millbrae municipal code requires that at least sixty percent of the front yard must be landscaped. Planning review of any hardscape in the front yard is required to ensure consistency with the minimum front yard landscape requirement. The landscaping requirement is intended to maintain rainwater absorption on each property, thereby decreasing strain on the existing storm system and rainwater runoff in the neighborhood. The front yard landscaping requirement is also intended to maintain a positive aesthetic and landscaped appearance in residential neighborhoods by prohibiting on-site parking in areas outside driveways and limiting excessive hardscape.

“Landscaped area” means any portion of a building site that is devoted to and maintained for the growing of live vegetative materials, such as trees, shrubs, grass (excluding synthetic grass), and ground cover for primarily decorative purposes. Such area may contain xeriscaping (landscaping with slow-growing, drought-tolerant plants and little or no irrigation), natural or manmade water features (such as ponds, streams, waterfalls, and fountains), and other amenities (such as walkways, retaining walls, patios, decks, arbors, trellises, raised planter beds, decorative stone/brick work, benches, lighting). Landscaped areas shall not be surfaced with concrete, asphalt, or other impervious materials, but shall be natural earth and may contain organic mulch (such as wood shavings and bark) or inorganic fillers (such as sand and gravel), and decorative rocks/boulders.

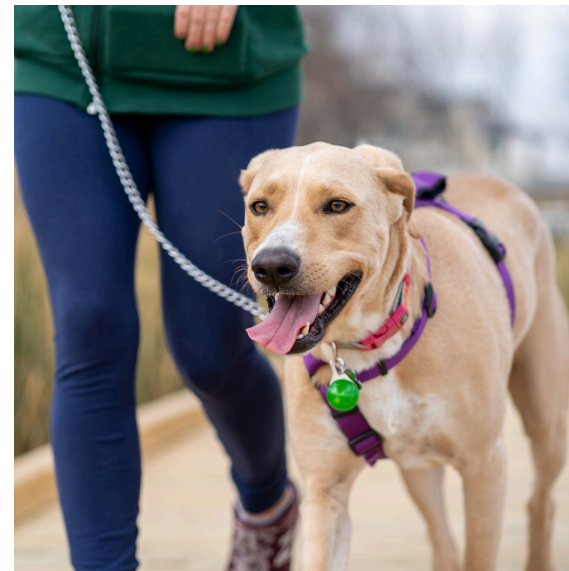


Leash Laws in Millbrae

There’s a leash law in the City of Millbrae! When out in public, your dog needs to be leashed and under your control. The City currently has one dog park at the Gateway at Millbrae Station on the westside of Rollins road North of Millbrae Avenue, available for public use during daylight hours.

We welcome dogs to utilize all our parks, but pursuant to law, they must remain on a leash continuously held by a person capable of controlling the dog. Please use our free dog bags throughout our parks to pick up your dog’s feces and help keep our parks clean for everyone!

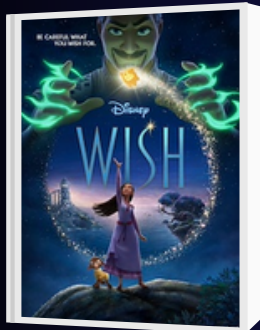
