

Impartial Analysis of Measure ____

Measure ____ was placed on the ballot by the Millbrae City Council Resolution 24-68 on July 9, 2024. This measure, if approved by the voters, adopts an ordinance to amend Section 2.05.050 of the Millbrae Municipal Code to expand the allowed time of service on the City Council to three successive four-year terms. Existing law limits service on the City Council to two successive four-year terms. Per Government Code Section 36502, any proposal to limit the number of terms that a member of the City Council may serve shall apply prospectively only.

Measure ____ states that any person appointed or elected to the City Council to fill an unexpired term shall be eligible to serve two successive four-year terms upon the expiration of the unexpired term for which that person was appointed or elected. Existing law is the same on this point.

A “yes” vote on Measure ____ is a vote to expand term limits. A “no” vote on Measure ____ is a vote to maintain current term limits.
