
The street sweeping program plays a crucial role in keeping Millbrae clean and beautiful by removing debris from streets, preventing litter from entering storm drains, and contributing to the health of our environment. With the introduction of the interactive map, residents can now:

- Easily Locate Sweeping Schedules:** View detailed maps to identify when street sweeping will occur in specific areas.
- Plan Ahead:** Avoid parking in restricted zones during scheduled cleaning times to ensure thorough street maintenance.

  - Be sure to select the specific categories you want, such as Public Works notifications, Resident Newsletters, or Storm Alerts.


