RENTING CITY FACILITIES IN MILLBRAE:

PICK YOUR SPACE!

Millbrae offers several venues for different types of events. From the spacious Millbrae Community Center to outdoor park facilities, you can choose the perfect space for your occasion. FREE HOME REPAIRS IN SAN MATEO COUNTY

Is your home as safe as it should be for a healthy environment for you and your family? If you have repair needs inside or at your home, you may qualify for free home repair service from Rebuilding Together Peninsula (RTP).

Since 1989, RTP has been providing safe and healthy housing-related repairs to homeowners-in-need throughout San Mateo County and the San Francisco Peninsula, at no cost to program recipients.

Typical service can include installation of grab bars and/or wheelchair ramps, replacement of faulty appliances, staircase restoration, cabinet repair, floor patching, minor electrical and plumbing work, door and fence repair, debris removal, painting, and much more.

Serviced by in-house technicians along with its network of trusted subcontractors and skilled volunteers, RTP services more than 100 low-income households each year, many of whom are seniors, veterans, or members of at-risk populations with limited means to address repairs on their own.

As Brenda, a Redwood City senior homeowner who recently received window, lighting, and floor repair service reflects, "If it wasn't for Rebuilding Together, I would stay with the damage...if it wasn't for them, I would still have severe problems. They were the only ones to help".

RTP also provides lead paint remediation for area homeowners, working within a San Mateo County program to identify affected homes. Homes built before 1978, and especially, pre-1950, are likely to have some levels of lead-based paint, which is known to pose health risks for residents, particularly children in development stages.

We want to remind everyone the importance of traffic safety and the adherence to traffic laws.

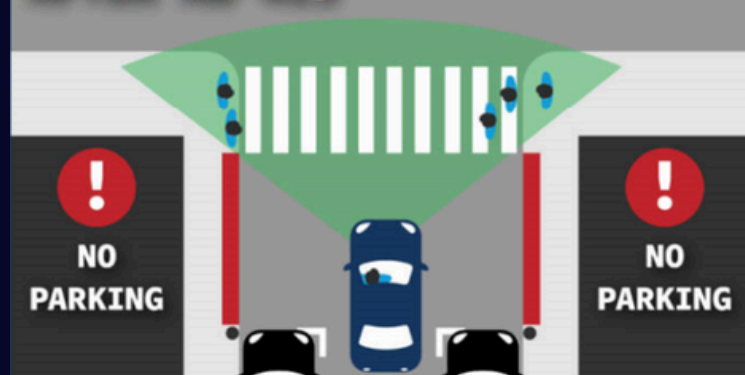
WHAT IS AB 413 - CALIFORNIA'S DAYLIGHTING LAW?

Makes intersections more visible to pedestrians and motorists by making it illegal to park within 20 feet of any marked or unmarked crosswalk. The goal of AB 413 is to improve the safety of pedestrians, bicyclists and drivers by increasing the overall visibility of crosswalks. Removing the obstruction of parked vehicles in close proximity to crosswalks allows drivers to have a clear view of those waiting to cross the street.
