# Rotary Club Beautifies Spur Trail with Adopt-a-Spot Project

As part of the City of Millbrae's Adopt-A-Spot Program, the Rotary Club of Millbrae recently completed a beautification project at the Spur Trail Taylor Boulevard trailhead. Under the leadership of Club President David Burris, Rotary Club members volunteered their time on a Saturday morning to plant 37 new shrubs and flowers and spread mulch around the site to help control weeds.

The Adopt-A-Spot Program is a collaborative effort between the City of Millbrae, the Community Enhancement Advisory Committee, and local community members. It empowers individuals, schools, and organizations to take part in maintaining the beauty and cleanliness of Millbrae's public spaces.



For this project, the Rotary Club generously donated \$500 worth of plants. In partnership, the City of Millbrae Parks staff prepared the site by installing a drip irrigation system, repairing the trail entrance sign, and digging planting holes. Thanks to this joint effort, the trailhead is now more inviting and better maintained for community use.

- A grassy lawn and updated landscaping
- New trees and a shaded picnic area
- Park benches
- A fenced pet area

Construction is expected to proceed over the coming months, with completion anticipated in early 2026.

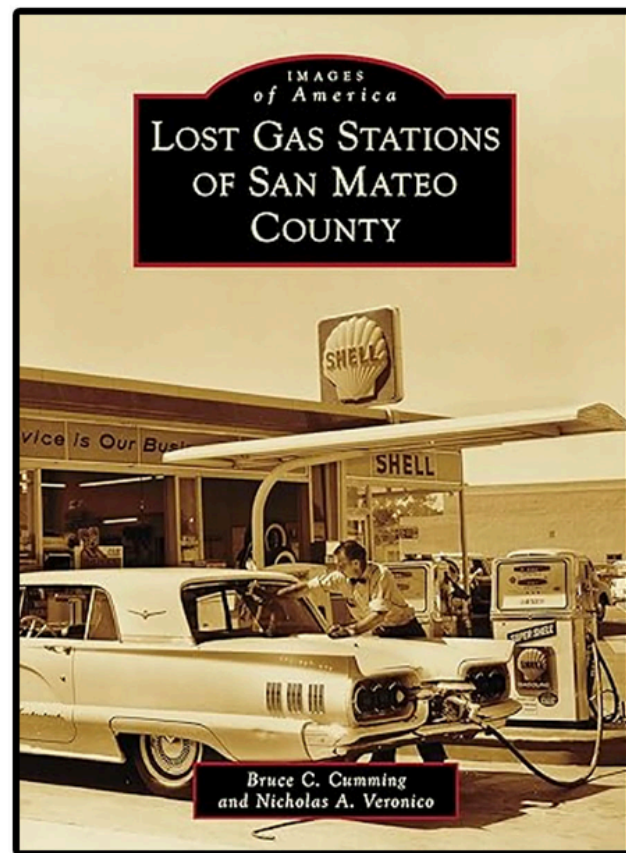

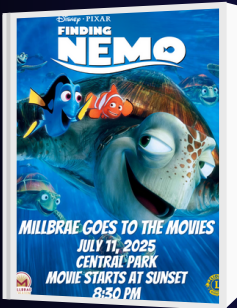
