**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE
ADOPTING THE SAN MATEO COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE**

WHEREAS, San Mateo County is vulnerable to certain natural hazards that could create a risk to life, property, environment and the County's economy; and

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event arises can reduce or eliminate those long-term risks; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre- and post-disaster hazard mitigation programs, allowing Millbrae to be eligible for hazard mitigation project funding; and

WHEREAS, in December 2015, a twenty-nine member coalition of partners within San Mateo County, including the County, Cities, Towns and Special Districts, was formed to pool resources and create uniform hazard mitigation strategies that can be consistently applied and used to ensure eligibility for specified grants for San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition developed an update to the San Mateo County Hazard Mitigation Plan (Plan) through planning efforts that included public outreach, an assessment of the risks and vulnerabilities to each individual area's natural hazards, and the development of mitigation action strategies; and

WHEREAS, the Plan identified and addressed mitigation action strategies for the County's seven hazards of concern including dam failure, earthquake, flood, landslide, severe weather, tsunami and wildfire, reflected in Volume I, and identified and addressed the mitigation strategies specific to Millbrae, contained in the Annex of Volume II of the Plan; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council adopt the Plan and implement the pre- and post- disaster mitigation action strategies as appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE:

- 1.) Adopts the updated San Mateo County Hazard Mitigation Plan (Plan); and
- 2.) Implements the pre- and post-disaster mitigation action strategies identified in the Plan as appropriate; and
- 3.) Continue to support the San Mateo County Hazard Mitigation Plan planning efforts.
