### CALL TO ORDER MILLBRAE CITY COUNCIL

Mayor Lee called the meeting to order at 7:19 P.M.

### NEW BUSINESS

Council Discussion and Selection of Vice Mayor

There was Council discussion regarding the selection of a Vice Mayor.

There was a motion/second by Oliva/Holober to nominate Councilmember Gottschalk for Vice Mayor.

There was a motion/second by Colapietro/Lee to nominate Councilmember Colapietro for Vice Mayor.

Begin public comment.

Vernon Bruce, Millbrae resident, stated that this was out of the normal order used to select a Vice Mayor and to please follow the tradition and appoint Councilmember Colapietro as Vice Mayor.

Jean Perry Verley, Millbrae resident, was astounded by the allegations of Councilmember Gottschalk at the October 22<sup>nd</sup> Council meeting and spoke in support of Councilmember Colapietro as Vice Mayor.

Natasha Shaw, Millbrae resident, stated that Councilmember Colapietro has worked tirelessly for the community. She noted that Councilmember Gottschalk's allegations at the October 22<sup>nd</sup> Council meeting were "old fashioned political muck raking". She asked that Council follow tradition and appoint Councilmember Colapietro as Vice Mayor.

Marlene McBride, Millbrae resident, spoke in favor of Councilmember Colapietro being appointed as Vice Mayor.

Brian McBride, Millbrae resident, asked that the Protocols be followed and to appoint Councilmember Marge Colapietro as Vice Mayor.

Randy Sahae, Millbrae resident, spoke in favor of Councilmember Colapietro being appointed as Vice Mayor and stated that the Council should follow the Protocols.

Councilmember Colapietro and Councilmember Gottschalk were each given two minutes to make their statements.

With both motions made, the following roll call vote reflects each Councilmembers decision:

Councilmember Gottschalk voted for himself for Vice Mayor  
Councilmember Oliva voted for Councilmember Colapietro as Vice Mayor  
Councilmember Holober voted for Councilmember Gottschalk as Vice Mayor  
Councilmember Colapietro voted for herself as Vice Mayor  
Mayor Lee voted for Councilmember Gottschalk as Vice Mayor

Councilmember Gottschalk received the majority vote 3:2 and was appointed Vice Mayor

City Attorney Joan Cassman administered the Oath of Office.
