**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE
ACCEPTING THE VICTORIA TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND
AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE SAN
MATEO COUNTY CLERK**

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 12-10 awarding a construction contract to W. Bradley Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$308,530.90 for the Victoria/ El Camino Real signalization project; and

WHEREAS, five contract change orders were issued to Contractor during the course of construction due to field changes and enhanced amenities such as a battery back-up system, LED safety lights, an audible pedestrian signal phase, a pedestrian signal head countdown, and tree replacements with a cost of \$53,342.65; and

WHEREAS, the final construction cost of the project, including all five contract change orders, is \$361,873.55 which is within the approved construction budget of \$370,530.90; and

WHEREAS, with the successful completion of the project, staff recommends that the Council accept the project and authorize the filing of a Notice of Completion.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae accepts the Victoria/El Camino Real Signalization Project as complete; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is authorized and directed to file a Notice of Completion with the San Mateo County Clerk.
