**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE  
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A REMOTE INFRARED VIDEO  
SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM FOR THE MILLBRAE SKATE PARK AND  
APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$11,000 IN BUDGET AUTHORITY FROM THE  
CITY'S GENERAL FUND BALANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Millbrae owns and operates the Millbrae Skate Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Millbrae Skate Park has been consistently vandalized over the last several years; and

**WHEREAS**, the City staff has spent numerous additional funds and staff hours cleaning up the park and they have had to shut down the Skate Park on occasion in order to perform this maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has met with various City Departments and local community stakeholders regarding the current circumstances at the Skate Park and has learned that the City of Redwood City has controlled the vandalism problem at its skate park with the installation of a video surveillance system; and


**WHEREAS**, staff has procured estimates from video surveillance and electrical vendors for the purchase of a remote infrared video surveillance system at the Millbrae Skate Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the system will provide the staff with instant notification via a wireless transmission of people entering the site during unauthorized hours to facilitate immediate response action; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of the surveillance system and electrical connection is estimated at \$11,000 to be paid for out of the City's General Fund balance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Millbrae authorizes the purchase of a remote infrared video surveillance system for the Millbrae Skate Park and appropriating an additional \$11,000 in budget authority from the City's General Fund balance to pay for the procurement and installation of this system.
