CALL TO ORDER MILLBRAE CITY COUNCIL

CITIZEN COMMUNICATION

Recommendation to approve tentative agreements between the City of Millbrae and the represented bargaining units (Sanitation Workers Association, Millbrae Police Officers Association, and Teamsters Local 856); and to authorize the City Manager to prepare and execute the respective Memorandum of Understanding
