**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE  
TO AUTHORIZE PURCHASING OF OFFICE FURNITURE FOR THE NEW  
OPERATIONS CENTER AT THE MILLBRAE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL  
PLANT**

**WHEREAS**, the City awarded a construction contract to West Bay Builders to renovate the Millbrae Water Pollution Control Plant in September 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the project included construction of a new Operations Center to house both Public Works Utilities & Operations as well as Water Pollution Control Plant staff; and

**WHEREAS**, the Operations Center is near completion and projected to be ready for occupancy by April 1, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, an architectural consultant designed the layout and furnishings in the new Operations Center to maximize worker production efficiencies, minimize long term maintenance costs, ensure modularity for future changes, and maximize ergonomic technology to minimize potential employee lost work time and worker's compensation cases; and

**WHEREAS**, new furniture for the Operations Center will be procured through the State's Department of General Services Procurement Program and therefore will not require competitive bidding; and


**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost to furnish the new Operations Center, including delivery, sales tax and setup, is approximately \$115,000; and


**WHEREAS**, the furniture procurement cost is included in the overall project budget for the Millbrae Water Pollution Control Plant Renovation Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Millbrae that the purchase of office furniture through the State's Department of General Services Procurement Program for the new Operations Center at the Millbrae Water Pollution Control Plant in the amount of \$115,000 is hereby authorized.
