

**RESOLUTION 11-31  
CITY OF MILLBRAE, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO  
STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**APPROVE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITIES OF MILLBRAE AND BURLINGAME  
FOR SHARING THE COST TO RESURFACE  
FRONTERA WAY**

**WHEREAS**, Frontera Way is located on the border between the cities of Burlingame and Millbrae;  
and

**WHEREAS**, City of Burlingame will be repaving Frontera Way and has proposed to the City to share the cost to repave the entire Frontera Way roadway instead of paving just Burlingame's half of Frontera Way; and

**WHEREAS**, staff believes that this is a great opportunity for the City to partner with the City of Burlingame and repave Frontera Way and at the same time save on project administrative costs as the City of Burlingame will be administering the contract including design, contract award and construction management; and

**WHEREAS**, Burlingame's current cost estimate to repave Frontera Way is approximately \$250,000 or \$125,000 for each city.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Millbrae hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the City of Burlingame to share the costs to repave Frontera Way up to a maximum of \$125,000.
