**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT DEWATERING PUMP
FROM FLO LINE INC. FOR THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT (WPCP)**

WHEREAS, the Millbrae Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP) currently utilizes a V-ram type solids pump to move biosolids from the belt filter press to the sludge trailer for ultimate disposal and the dewatering of bio-solids is a critical step in treating waste water and complying with the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit; and


WHEREAS, the current V-ram pump is over 20 years old, exceeding the typical service life for this type of pump which is 10 to 15 years, and thus this pump is no longer supported by its manufacturer, the pump is near catastrophic failure, and no alternate means of pumping dewatered sludge is available; and

WHEREAS, staff obtained 3 bids for replacing the V-ram pump and Flo Line Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder proposing a replacement turn-key pump system for \$131,266; and

WHEREAS, the budget for replacing this pump was approved as part of the FY 11-12 Sanitation Enterprise Fund budget and staff recommends awarding a purchasing contract to Flo Line Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae that the City Manager is authorized to award a purchasing contract to Flo Line Inc. for replacing the WPCP's biosolids transfer pump for \$131,266.
