**AMENDING CITY COUNCIL PROTOCOLS TO CALL FOR RESCHEDULING OF  
REGULARLY SCHEDULED COUNCIL MEETINGS THAT FALL ON ELECTION  
DAYS**

**WHEREAS**, the manner in which the City Council of the City of Millbrae conducts business is guided by a set of Protocols that the City Council first adopted by Resolution No. 98-109 enacted on December 8, 1998; and

**WHEREAS**, since initial adoption, the City Council has seen fit to revise these Protocols on eight occasions, the most recent revision of which occurred by Resolution No. 10-08 on February 23, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council now desires to further amend the "Council Protocols" to address the cancellation of regularly scheduled meetings that coincide with election days.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Millbrae City Council hereby amends the City Council Protocols to add a sentence to Section I.5, "**Cancellation of Regular Meetings,**" to read as follows: "When a regularly scheduled Council meeting falls on a state or federal primary or general election day, the meeting will be held the following Tuesday."


