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**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE  
APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR THE 2017 SANITARY SEWER MAINS AND  
LATERAL SMOKE TESTING PROJECT TO NATIONAL PLANT SERVICES,  
INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$400,620**

**WHEREAS**, on or about November 15, 2016, the City and the San Francisco Baykeeper reached an agreement to extend the consent decree by two years to November 15, 2018 in order to allow additional time to implement the revised capacity assurance report that focuses on Rainfall Dependent Inflow and Infiltration (RDII) strategies; and


**WHEREAS**, one of the major components of the revised capacity assurance report is to smoke test the entire collection system in order to detect defects in the sanitary sewer collection system that allow storm water and rain water to enter into the sanitary sewer collection system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City issued a Notice to Bidders on April 13, 2017 inviting interested contractors to submit their bids for the 2017 Sanitary Sewer Mains and Lateral Smoke Testing Project which includes smoke testing of approximately 15 miles of sanitary sewer mains and 500 sanitary sewer laterals.

**WHEREAS**, on or about May 2, 2017 the City Clerk Office received one single bid submitted by National Plant Services, Inc. in the amount of \$400,620.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE** to award a service contract with National Plant Services, Inc. in the amount of \$400,620, and authorize the City Manager to execute the subject contract and all potential contract amendments of up to 10% of the original contract amount or \$40,000 for contingency and 10% for Inspection and Construction Management (\$40,000) to smoke test approximately 15 miles of sanitary sewer mains and 500 sanitary sewer laterals.


