CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION


WHEREAS, on March 25, 2016, staff submitted an application for a Systemic Safety Analysis Report Program (SSARP) grant to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to evaluate the safety of the Millbrae Avenue Corridor. The study area encompass Millbrae Avenue from State Route 82 (El Camino Real) to Old Bayshore Highway including the five intersections along the Corridor: El Camino Real & Millbrae Avenue; Rollins Road & Millbrae Avenue; US101 Southbound On/Off Ramp & Millbrae Avenue; US101 Northbound Off Ramp & Millbrae Avenue; and Old Bayshore Highway & Millbrae Avenue; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2017, the City was formally notified by Caltrans that the City will receive a grant of \$49,500 with a local match requirement of \$5,500; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae to approve both the Agency-Federal Master Agreement No. 00029S and Program Supplemental Agreement No. 0P86 Rev. 000 with Caltrans; and
