**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE ESTABLISHING THE
APPROPRIATION LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-18**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Millbrae established the appropriations limit applicable to the District during the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 as \$32,037,426; and


WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California Constitution and Sections 7902(b) and 7910 of the Government Code require that each local agency subject thereto establish, by resolution, the applicable appropriations limit on an annual basis by applying to the previous year's appropriations limit two factors, as issued by the California Department of Finance, reflecting changes in the California per capita personal income and in population; and

WHEREAS, the calculations showing the applications of those factors have been forwarded to the City Council for review and have been made available for public inspection at least fifteen days prior to the date hereof; and

WHEREAS, the applicable factors for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 are as follows: (1) the change in the California per capita personal income was 3.69%; and (2) the applicable change in population from January 2016 to January 2017 was 0.09%.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE that the Appropriation Limit for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 is established as: \$33,248,440.

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-18**

Section 7910 of the California Government Code requires each local government agency to determine during each fiscal year the appropriations limit pursuant to Article XIII B of the California Constitution applicable during the following fiscal year. The limit must be adopted at a regularly scheduled meeting or a noticed special meeting, and the documentation used in determining the limit must be made available for public review fifteen days prior to such meeting.

Set below is the methodology to be used to calculate the Fiscal Year 2017-18 appropriations limit for the City. The limit as set forth below will be considered and adopted at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Millbrae City Council on June 26, 2017.

1. Appropriations limit for the fiscal year 2016-17	\$32,037,426
2. Population change**	0.09%
(January 1, 2016 – January 1, 2017)	
3. Change in California per Capita Personal Income**	3.69%
(January 1, 2016 – January 1, 2017)	
4. Fiscal Year 2017-18 adjustment factor (1.0009 x 1.0369).....	1.0378
5. Fiscal Year 2017-18 appropriations limit (32,037,426 x 1.0378).....	\$33,248,440
