Stormwater Requirements

for

Small Projects and Single-Family Homes

Effective December 1, 2012, all small projects and single-family residences must comply with the Municipal Regional Stormwater Permit Requirements (MRP). These include projects that create and/or replace more than 2,500 square feet, but less than 10,000 square feet of impervious surface. (If your project creates more than 10,000 square feet of impervious surface these are considered regulated projects and you should already be complying with the MRP requirements.)

In order to comply with the MRP, these projects must incorporate at least one of these six site design measures:

- (1) Collect roof runoff into cisterns or rain barrels
- (2) Channel roof runoff into vegetated areas
- (3) Channel runoff from sidewalks, walkways, and patios with impervious surfaces onto vegetated areas
- (4) Channel runoff from driveways and uncovered parking spaces with impervious onto vegetated areas
- (5) Construct sidewalks, walkways, and/or patios with permeable surfaces
- (6) Construct driveways and/or uncovered parking spaces with permeable surfaces.

No water treatment measures are required for these projects.
