Millbrae Municipal Code, Section 10.10.300:

SECTION 10.10.300 TEMPORARY SIGNS

A. Temporary Signs Not Requiring Design Review or a Sign Permit.

1. **Election Signs.** Election signs shall be placed on private property with the consent of the private property owner and/or the occupant of the private property. No signs shall be erected upon any public property or upon any public right-of-way as specified in Section 10.10.340(A).

Signs shall be removed within ten days following the election by the person who erected the sign or the owner/occupant of the property upon which the sign is erected. Each candidate, campaign committee or authorized representative shall sign an affidavit assuring removal of all elections signs.

The California Department of Transportation and the Pacific Gas and Electric Company also have regulations regarding the placement of political signs. Keep in mind that El Camino Real is a State highway.
