**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE
ACCEPTING THE 2018 SANITARY SEWER MAINS CLEANING AND
INSPECTION PROJECT AS COMPLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING
OF A NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE SAN MATEO COUNTY CLERK**

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-13 awarding a construction contract to AIMS/PVIC CA, LLC dba AIMS Companies (AIMS Companies) in the amount of \$250,076 for the 2018 Sanitary Sewer Mains Cleaning and Inspection Project (Project) and approving a Project contingency of \$37,000; and

WHEREAS, a Notice to Proceed was issued to AIMS Companies in June 2018 and AIMS Companies began work soon after issuance of the Notice to Proceed; and

WHEREAS, AIMS Companies has successfully completed all contract work, including the cleaning and inspection of 15.3 miles of sanitary sewer mains; and

WHEREAS, one contract change order totaling \$7,754 was executed to pay for additional work, a second contract resulting from corrections of sizes and locations of sewer mains and a second change order to rebalance resulted in a final credit of \$39,879; and

WHEREAS, the total contract was \$217,951 which is \$32,125 below the total Project funding approved by the City Council on April 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, staff performed the final inspection on the Project and determined all work has been satisfactorily completed with the Project plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council accept the Project as complete and authorize the filing of a Notice of Completion with the San Mateo County Clerk.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE accepts the 2018 Sanitary Sewer Mains Cleaning and Inspection Project as complete and authorizes the filing of the Notice of Completion with the San Mateo County Clerk.
