WHEREAS, *the goal of the ADP is to continue the modernization of SFO, enhance passenger experience, and support facilities to existing runway capacity; and*

WHEREAS, *the Airport has great economic impact on Millbrae; nearly 1,500 Millbrae residents work at SFO; Millbrae has earned income of nearly \$98 million and SFO generates a significant amount of tax revenue for Millbrae.*

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the members of the Millbrae City Council do hereby commend






