RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO GOLDEN BAY CONSTRUCTION, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$357,162 FOR THE MAGNOLIA AVENUE AND RICHMOND DRIVE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (CONTRACT), ESTABLISHING A PROJECT CONTINGENCY OF \$53,000, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TJKM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000 FOR CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING SUPPORT SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT, AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS UP TO THE AMOUNT OF THE PROJECT CONTINGENCY FUND

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2017, the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) issued a Call for Projects to fund pedestrian and bicycle improvement projects to improve bicycling and walking accessibility and safety within San Mateo County, as well as to encourage more residents to participate in active transportation; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-06 authorizing the City Manager to execute a funding agreement with the TA for the Magnolia Avenue and Richmond Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project (Project) in the amount of \$260,000; and

WHEREAS, the Magnolia Avenue and Richmond Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project will improve the bicycle and pedestrian connectivity along Magnolia Avenue between the City limits and the cities of San Bruno and Burlingame and make safety and infrastructure improvements including installing new bicycle routes, and improving signing and striping in the Project area; and

WHEREAS, the City published a Notice to Bidders inviting interested bidders to submit their sealed bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2019, the City Clerk received eight (8) bids and publicly opened and read the bids; and

WHEREAS, the apparent responsive and responsible low bidder is Golden Bay Construction, Inc. (GBC) with a base bid of \$357,162; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council award the contract for the Project to GBC in the amount of \$357,162; and

WHEREAS, the Project requires the construction engineering support services and staff has negotiated a scope of work with the City Traffic Engineer, TJKM, in the amount of \$20,000 to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, staff also recommended that the City Council approve a project contingency of \$53,000 for additional work as needed during construction; and


WHEREAS, there are funds available in the Fiscal Year 2019 capital and special budget which, combined with the TA grant funding of \$260,000, are sufficient to cover the cost of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE hereby awards a construction contract to Golden Bay Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$357,162 for the Magnolia Avenue and Richmond Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Projects and establishes a project contingency of \$53,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement with TJKM Transportation Consultants in the amount of \$20,000 for construction engineering, construction management, and inspection services for the Project; and

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Contract, Agreement, and any contract change orders up to the Project contingency amount of \$53,000.
