**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE
AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO INTERSTATE GRADING
AND PAVING INC. FOR THE 2019 PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$2,362,114, ESTABLISHING A PROJECT CONTINGENCY OF
\$355,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO
EXECUTE THE SUBJECT CONTRACT(S) AND CHANGE ORDERS UP TO
THE AGGREGATE PROJECT CONTINGENCY AMOUNT**

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-34 approving the budget for Fiscal Years (FY) 2018-19 and 2019-20 and the Capital and Special Projects Five Year Plan for FY 2019 – 2023; and

WHEREAS, the adopted budget included \$4.0 million in funding for street reconstruction and resurfacing for FY 2018-19; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 Pavement Repair Project will include removal and replacement of roadway asphalt, repairs to the base and subbase as needed, upgrading existing curb ramps to be compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and replacement of all affected striping, markings traffic loops, utility (sewer/water) manholes and survey monuments at the following locations: Bayview Avenue/Bayview Court, Springfield Drive, Valencia Avenue, Lake Street, Toyon Drive and Broadway (Project); and

WHEREAS, funding for this Project was included and approved in the FY 18-19 budget and the Capital and Special Projects Five Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2019 – 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City published a Notice to Bidders soliciting interested bidders to submit sealed bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2019, the City Clerk received five (5) bids and publicly opened and read the bid; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Interstate Grading and Paving Inc. (Interstate) in the amount of \$1,943,831, which is below the Engineer's Estimate of \$2,579,900 and

WHEREAS, Staff also recommends the inclusion of Alternate Bid Item 2 as part of this approved contract in the amount of \$418,282, but does not recommend including Alternate Bid Items #1 and #3 due to funding constraints; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the City Council award the contract to Interstate for a total amount of \$2,362,114 for the Project; and


WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the City Council approve a Project contingency of \$355,000 to fund additional work such as unforeseen subsurface site conditions as needed and to cover project administration costs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE hereby awards a construction contract to Interstate Grading and Paving Inc. in the amount of \$2,362,114 for the 2019 Pavement Repair Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae establishes a Project contingency in the amount of \$355,000 (approximately 15%) in order to address any unforeseen site conditions and/or additional work required to complete the Project; and

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute a contract with Interstate for the Project and any amendments or change orders up to the Project contingency.
