RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO INTERSTATE GRADING & PAVING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$470,270 FOR THE TAYLOR MIDDLE SCHOOL SAFE ROUTE TO SCHOOL AND GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE PILOT PROJECT (CONTRACT), ESTABLISHING A PROJECT CONTINGENCY OF \$70,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT, AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS UP TO THE AMOUNT OF THE PROJECT CONTINGENCY FUND

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2017, the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County (C/CAG) issued a Call for the Safe Routes to Schools/Green Infrastructure Pilot Program (Program) which is intended to fund integrated improvements within the public right-of-way that increase safety for children walking and biking to school, while also improving water quality, increasing urban greening, and enhancing the pedestrian environment; and

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2018, the City of Millbrae executed a funding agreement to receive \$212,000 from C/CAG for the Taylor Middle School Safe Route to School and Green Infrastructure Pilot Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Project will create urban greening awareness, and improve the bicycle and pedestrian safety at the five-way intersection of Taylor Boulevard, Ashton Avenue, and Almenar Street; and

WHEREAS, the City published a Notice to Bidders inviting interested bidders to submit their sealed bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2019, the City Clerk received twelve (12) bids and publicly opened and read the bids; and

WHEREAS, the apparent responsive and responsible low bidder is Interstate Grading & Paving, Inc. (IGP) with a base bid of \$470,270; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council award the contract for the Project to IGP in the amount of \$470,270; and

WHEREAS, staff also recommends that the City Council approve a Project contingency of \$70,000 for additional work as needed during construction; and

WHEREAS, there are funds available in the Fiscal Year 2019 Capital Improvement Program budget which, combined with the C/CAG grant fund of \$212,000, are sufficient to cover the Project costs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE hereby awards a construction contract to Interstate Grading & Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$470,270 for the Taylor Middle School Safe Route to School and Green Infrastructure Pilot Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute a contract with IGP and any amendments or contract change orders up to the Project contingency amount of \$70,000.
