AMENDING CITY COUNCIL PROTOCOLS TO CALL FOR RESCHEDULING OF
REGULARLY SCHEDULED COUNCIL MEETINGS THAT FALL ON ELECTION
DAYS

WHEREAS, the manner in which the City Council of the City of Millbrae conducts business is guided by a set of Protocols that the City Council first adopted by Resolution No. 98-109 enacted on December 8, 1998; and

WHEREAS, since initial adoption, the City Council has seen fit to revise these Protocols on eight occasions, the most recent revision of which occurred by Resolution No. 10-08 on February 23, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to further amend the "Council Protocols" to address the cancellation of regularly scheduled meetings that coincide with election days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Millbrae City Council hereby amends the City Council Protocols to add a sentence to Section I.5, "**Cancellation of Regular Meetings**," to read as follows: "When a regularly scheduled Council meeting falls on a state or federal primary or general election day, the meeting will be held the following Tuesday."
