RECOMMENDATION:

Consider appointment of two City Councilmembers for the purpose of forming an Ad-Hoc Subcommittee of the City Council to address Opportunities for Economic Development and a Strategic Alliance with SFO.

BACKGROUND:

As a neighbor to San Francisco International Airport (SFO), the City of Millbrae has potentially untapped business and economic development opportunities by further collaborating with SFO. As one of the largest International Airports in the world, SFO employs more than 40,000 people and more than 50 million guests travel through the airport annually. SFO plans to expand the capacity of the airport to accommodate 75 million guest travelers in the near term future.

Given SFO expansion plans, the proximity of Millbrae to the airport, and the need to further stimulate the local economy, the time is appropriate to initiate improved relations with SFO and work in partnership to benefit both SFO and City of Millbrae needs.

ANALYSIS:

As means to begin addressing economic development opportunities; attracting potential spill over demand from SFO employees and travelers; and improving the partnership with SFO, it is critical that Millbrae starts leading the way. A City Council Ad Hoc subcommittee will allow the City and staff to proceed effectively, develop a work program and eventually make recommendations to the full City Council about how best to proceed and implement a strategic partnership with SFO.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with the formation of the subject Ad-Hoc Subcommittee.

COUNCIL ACTION:

Nominate by motion, second and a majority vote two City Councilmembers for the purpose of forming an Ad-Hoc Subcommittee of the City Council to address opportunities for economic development in partnership with SFO.
