**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE THIRD
ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT WITH EISENBERG, OLIVIERI &
ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL STORMWATER
INSPECTION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Commercial and Industrial Stormwater Inspection is a requirement of the San Francisco Bay Municipal Regional Stormwater Permit Order No. R2-20150049; and

WHEREAS, in the past, San Mateo County Environmental Health Services (CEH) performed such inspections for cities within the County of San Mateo; and

WHEREAS, effective December 31, 2017, CEH no longer provides this service; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the City of Pacifica issued a Request for Proposals for commercial and industrial stormwater inspections and awarded a contract to Eisenberg, Olivieri & Associates, Inc. (EOA) for inspection services; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2018, the City piggybacked on the City of Pacifica's agreement and executed a professional services agreement with EOA for inspection services for \$24,800 for 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City has issued two (2) addendums increasing the compensation within the City Manager's authority; and

WHEREAS, EOA has demonstrated a clear understanding of Millbrae's Commercial and Industrial Stormwater Control Program and has collaborated successfully with City staff in the past year and a half; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to continue inspection services with EOA and recommends that the City Council authorize the City Manager to execute a third addendum to the agreement with EOA to extend the contract term by one year to June 30, 2020 and increase the total compensation by \$60,000 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$101,150.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute the third addendum to the agreement with Eisenberg, Olivieri & Associates, Inc. for commercial and industrial stormwater inspection services to extend the contract term by one year to June 30, 2020 and increase compensation by \$60,000 for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 to a total not-to-exceed amount of \$101,150.
