**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE
AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO YERBA BUENA
ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE LARKSPUR PUMP
STATION RETAINING WALL PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2018, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-34 approving the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 through Fiscal Year 2022-2023; and

WHEREAS, the adopted capital budget includes \$200,000 in funding related to Pump Station Rehabilitation for Fiscal Year 2018-2019; and

WHEREAS, the Larkspur Pump Station Retaining Wall Project (Project) will include replacing the existing redwood retaining wall with a new wall constructed of reinforced concrete and designed to meet current seismic code; and

WHEREAS, the City posted an informal bid through the City website and notified the required trade journals inviting interested contractors to submit their bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2019 at 2:00 pm, four (4) bids were received; and

WHEREAS, the lowest, responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Yerba Buena Engineering & Construction, Inc. (Yerba Buena) in the amount of \$155,685; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council award the contract to Yerba Buena for a total amount of \$155,685 for the Project; and

WHEREAS, staff also recommends that the City Council approve a Project contingency of \$24,000 to address any unforeseen and/or additional work required to complete the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE hereby awards a construction contract to Yerba Buena Engineering & Construction, Inc. for the Larkspur Pump Station Wall Project in the amount of \$155,685; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae authorizes a Project contingency of \$24,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or his designee to execute the contract and all contract change orders up to the project contingency amount of \$24,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Millbrae authorize the roll-forward of capital funds from Fiscal Year 2018 – 2019 to Fiscal Year 2019 – 2020 for the Project.
