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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLBRAE  
ESTABLISHING SALARY RANGES FOR PART-TIME, TEMPORARY AND  
SEASONAL CLASSIFICATIONS IN COMPLIANCE WITH STATE MINIMUM  
WAGE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2020, the minimum wage in California will increase from \$12.00 to \$13.00. The revised salary schedule would increase the starting pay rate for these part-time non-benefited positions to a minimum of \$13.00; and

WHEREAS, the salary ranges for the lowest steps in the Junior Recreation Leader and Recreation Leader I positions are less than \$13.00 per hour and need to be adjusted; and

WHEREAS, the revised salary schedule will also adjust the starting pay rate and salary ranges of other part-time non-benefited classifications in the Recreation Leader series to maintain internal relationships.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the revised salary ranges for part-time, temporary and seasonal classifications are in compliance with the State minimum wage law effective January 1, 2020.
